- Government of India is implementing Environment Education Awareness and Training scheme across the country to promote environmental awareness and mobilize student's participation in activities related to environment management & conservation.

REPORT FOR 2018

Under the GLOBE programme, nearly 750 schools (150 schools in each State) proposed to be made active in 2019-20 in five States (one from each region North, South, East, West and Central India)

- ✓ Madhya Pradesh,
- ✓ Kerala,
- ✓ Odisha,
- ✓ Rajasthan and
- ✓ Gujarat

- Rs 20 lakh (29,000 USD) for each State shall be allocated to conduct GLOBE activities.
- GLOBE training kits and trainings shall be provided to States in coordination with GLOBE Asia-Pacific Regional Office, Indian Environmental Society, New Delhi.
- Henceforth India shall be actively involved in GLOBE programme in coordination with Globe Implementation office, Boulder, Colorado, United States alongwith the GLOBE Asia-Pacific Regional Office, Indian Environmental Society, New Delhi

GLOBE Activities in India (2018-19)

- ✓ Trainings to teachers under Zika Education and prevention project: Four trainings were held in Delhi Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat. Nearly 100 students/teachers, participated.
- ✓ Remaining 2 trainings are scheduled to be completed by June 2019.
