# Highlight Strategy

Collaborations/connections to Peace Corps, -

ECCA had dialogues and meetings with Peace Corps and its volunteers but could not go ahead as there priorities were changed to food securities.

For increasing health technical person support ECCA has met many health officials but they are keep on changing after the province system. It will be problem till new structure finalized. As in many part of Nepal the many people were affected with **Dengue** diseases, ECCA has developed the project and proposed to KMW for preparing school stakeholders for the precaution from mosquito diseases.

School Clubs had done rally on mosquito disease precautions in East Nepal during Dengue threat in their areas.
